### Further suggestions on consultation

- Local authorities (councillors and officials). Talisman could speak to appropriate committee (contact cllr. Mike MacMillan).
- Highland Renewables Energy Group (who are trying to secure contracts)
- Not all fishermen are aware – need to explore further, don't just rely on Moray Firth Fisheries Action Group.
- Try vessel registry to contact fishermen.
- Background safety/shipping/navigation information that is not in the report needs to be made available - on [www.beatricewind.co.uk](http://www.beatricewind.co.uk) and/or through MFP.
- Community Councils – give them plenty of time to respond. Write directly to Community Council chairs.
- Give information directly, not just website – assumes people have access and will/can go to website.
- Put information through fish selling offices to reach skippers.
